

Guidelines for playing recreational golf safely (Covid-19)

## Before playing



### RESPECT

Respect all safety measures indicated by the Club.



### AVOID

Avoid physical greeting, shake hands etc.



### BOOKINGS

Must be booked on line or by phone.



### GREENFEES

Payment of green fees will preferably be made on line or by phone with a credit card. The Club House will remain open, with the Social Hall closed, to allow players access to the course and bathrooms.



### BUGGIES

Buggies can be used individually or family. Before and after each use they will be disinfected by the Club staff.



### TROLLEYS

Manual and electric trolleys for individual use will be disinfected by Club staff before and after each use.



### FLIGHT

The flight may be of 4 players who must keep the social distance during the game.



### EQUIPMENT

Players must come dressed for the game as the Club facilities will be closed.




### TEE TIME

Players must go from the parking directly to the Reception and to Tee 1, 5 minutes before your tee time.

## During the game




### DISTANCE

It should be kept the social distance, 2 m, during all the way.



### DO NOT TOUCH

It is not allowed to touch sinks, fountains, seats, etc. which will remain closed.



### BUNKERS

The bunkers will be repaired in the best possible way by the player without the use of rakes.



### FLAGS

The hole flags must always remain in stand, they can not remove or touch.



### HOLES


The holes must have a stop that prevents the ball from descending completely at the end of the hole. The player will collect the ball with the greatest possible prevention.



### PLAY FAST

Ready Golf, play fast, it is not allowed to give way to another flight.

## After the game




### FAREWELL

Avoid long goodbyes and any physical contact.



### CLEANING

Cleaning of clubs and shoes is not allowed.



### PARKING

It is recommended to go directly from the Golf Course to the parking.
